

Abstract:**Explaining the Viewpoints of Faculty Members on Challenges and Solutions for the Implementation of Professional Ethics: qualify study****Introduction:**

In the medical community, the discussion of ethics has a special place due to the importance of this profession, and dentistry, like others of branches of medical sciences need such attention, so the present study aims to explaining the challenges of implementing professional ethics in Dentistry was performed as a qualitative study.

Methods and materials:

The present study was a qualitative study that was conducted as a content analysis and contextual analysis. Method data collection was done by interviewing 20 faculty members in an accessible manner with results and based on purpose. Interview with permission participants were recorded and implemented, the main components were extracted and themes and sub-themes were identified and analyzed background-based data was used by NVivo software version 12 to summarize, classify, and articulate data.

Results:

The results of a study of 20 faculty members of Ardabil Dental School showed that the challenges and obstacles to the implementation of professional ethics in dentistry can be divided into six levels: greed, low awareness of professional ethics, abuse of power, insufficient time, factors classified educational and managerial and academic factors.

Conclusion:

The faculty view on ethical issues is very broad, the mentioned challenges can be addressed with suggestions given and better management of education and cultural issues minimized or eliminated.
